

Rebuilding Together of Northwest Arkansas
Homeowner Qualifying Guidelines - **Rebuilding Day Program**
Revised: 7/17/07

Although these qualifications shall be used as guidelines during the home selection process, it was agreed that all applications would be considered on a case-by-case basis. It is clearly recognized that there can be extenuating circumstances that can override these basic guidelines.

1. Applicants must own and occupy the home and property.
2. Applicants shall be low-income (see income guidelines below) and disabled, elderly or families with children.

3. The Applicants must be financially and / or physically unable to do the work themselves. The value of the dwelling shall be taken into consideration when qualifying an applicant.
4. All able applicants and their families must be willing to assist with the project or not be present on Rebuilding Day. Applicants should show a willingness to help make the process a quality volunteer experience.
5. Rebuilding Together of Northwest Arkansas major focus when selecting homes is:
 - a. Safety
 - b. Warmth
 - c. Keeping homeowners in their homes
6. Homeowners must assure Rebuilding Together of Northwest Arkansas that they do not intend to sell their homes in the next two years.
7. The home must be in Washington or Benton Counties.
8. The project must be a safe working environment for volunteers.
